Subj: VOLUNTARY TERMINATION OF DUTY IN A FLYING STATUS FOR [REDACTED] /75 [REDACTED] USMC

1. [REDACTED] informed me of his decision to terminate his flight status in early May 2010 due to ongoing, significant personal stressors which were affecting his flight performance.
2. [REDACTED] completed a flight physical on 27 October 2009. Additionally, I conducted a full physical and mental health examination on 11 June 2010.
3. There were no disqualifying conditions identified. He does have approved NAMI waivers for PRK surgery and a history of migraine headaches. Neither condition has affected his flying. He successfully completed the Self-Paced Airsickness Desensitization (SPAD) Protocol in May 2009 at NAMI, after ongoing air/motion sickness problems, and had no further issues.
4. [REDACTED] remains medically fit for jobs in the Marine Corps and is fit for full duty.
